## MISSOURI MUSIC FESTIVALS ANNOUNCE MOZARK FEST WITH A SALUTE TO THE SEVENTIES

The Seventies, well known for its music as Mozark Fest will feature some of the top Tribute Bands in the United States featuring music from Santana, Phil Collins, Hall and Oates, Eagles, Queen, Heart, Journey, REO Speedwagon, Alabama, George Strait, Garth Brooks, Chris Stapleton, Kenny Chesney and Tim McGraw.
